How has the staff at Club Regina Los Cabos made an impact on your vacations? Any that have stood out over the years that you'd like to highlight?



We hear you're a real 'foodie'. What are some of your favorite restaurants of all time in Puerto Vallarta?

I have several: La Langosta Feliz, Sonora la Sur, Casa Tradicional, Barcelona Tapas, Mariscos la Tía, El Brujo, La Palapa, and Hacienda Mamá Nena. But the street food is also great: I love the volcano and steak tacos in the El Caloso neighborhood, the churros at the back of the Ley store, the rib tacos at Roque's, the birria quesadillas from Don Toño, Los Arrieros in the La Aurora neighborhood, the shrimp burgers in El Palmar de Aramara, and the seafood burritos from Tacón de Marlin.

What's one thing our members may be surprised to learn about you?

Probably that I started working when I was 10 years old, cleaning shelves and arranging cans in a supermarket. That in my earlier years I worked as a waiter, a brick maker, a bread baker, a security guard in one of the most popular clubs in Vallarta, a bank cashier, a license inspector at city hall, an airport taxi driver, and at a travel agency for more than 8 years before starting my journey in the hotel industry. I started as a bellboy and then moved to concierge, but I really enjoyed being a bellboy more than anything!
