With summer right around the corner, it's not just the weather that's warming, travel is also heating up! As more news of vaccinations spreading instead of the virus, vacationers are ready to reclaim their much needed trips. According to Tripadvisor's 2021 Summer Travel Index, over two-thirds of Americans (67%) are planning to travel this summer (June 1 - August 31), which is a 17% increase from those who traveled this spring (March 1- May 31). Although many still plan to drive to their destination (43%), 19% plan to fly, up 4% from this spring. Trips are getting longer too- their forecast shows 57% of Americans will take a 7- to 10-day vacation this summer, with 74% traveling domestically and 13% traveling internationally.

As warm weather months get closer so too are airline ticket sales increasing. Spring break was the first time the TSA started seeing the US daily passenger count regularly reach over 1 million. And the Mother's Day had the highest number since the pandemic started with 1.7 people flying from US airports. Travelers are feeling safe to fly again, and the airlines are responding to the demand by reopening many more daily flights and direct routes to key vacation destinations.



Our Raintree Vacation Club Resorts have all gone through rigorous training and made physical and operational adjustments at the property to ensure the greatest safety for everyone who visits. Most are seeing their highest number of reservations for this summer since the pandemic started, and cannot be more thrilled to welcome members back. While a sense of normalcy is increasing, some restrictions remain at each of our properties. The restrictions vary according to the local government mandates.

In Mexico, for example, our resorts cannot operate at full occupancy, instead they are limited to open only 50-60% of their units. So as demand increases with limited number of rooms, finding availability during popular times may be more challenging at our Club Regina resorts; we encourage you to book early and check back in often with a Raintree Vacation Guide to see if anything has opened up. Currently all our US resorts are allowed to open at 100% occupancy, but many of their amenities, including the pools, have occupancy limits and/or require reservations.


CeCe Holman at Club Regina Los Cancun




Where's your favorite spot in the resort? Sitting on the beautiful beach, swimming in the Gulf!



Continuing in Raintree Vacation Club's efforts to "Go Green", Members have the option to opt in for Electronic Maintenance Fee statements instead of the paper statements that are mailed to the address on file.

Through the maintenance fee section after logging on to www.raintreevacationclub.com with their credentials, Members can opt in to these benefits by following the steps below:

1. Log into [raintreevacationclub.com](http://www.raintreevacationclub.com) using your personalized credentials and click on **"Pay Your Maintenance Fee"**
2. In the Options section, select **"E-Statement History"**:
3. This will open your E-Statement
4. Mark the **"Send me e-statement notifications"** checkbox.

Select the accounts for which you would like to receive E-statements.


