Our Three Kings Day Tradition at Club Regina

January 6th

"Three Kings Day"

As an extension of the Christmas holiday, this day is a celebration of the three Wise Men and focuses on gift giving, family, and delicious treats. For many children in Mexico, it's the three Wise Men who bring Christmas gifts, not Santa Claus, and in the days leading up to the holiday, kids will write letters with their hopes and dreams to the Magi. And instead of leaving out milk and cookies, shoes filled with hay for the kings' camels are left out on January 5th, so the next morning children will find their shoes now filled with candy and small gifts.

Another key feature of Three Kings Day in Mexico is rosca de reyes, or "kings' cake". This flaky pastry is shared between family and friends on January 6, and somewhere within the cake is hidden a little plastic baby figurine. According to Mexico tradition, whoever finds the baby in their cake gets to invite those present to a meal of tamales on February 2, the Candlemas Day, a day that celebrates the Virgin Mary.


