2019 RESORT IMPROVEMENTS

Here are some highlights of the updates made in 2019 that you're most likely to notice on your next visit to a Club Regina resort.

CLUB REGINA PUERTO VALLARTA A RAINTREE VACATION CLUB RESORT

- Access to gardens at Tower B: Tile floor replaced with non-slip textured concrete floor for safety
- Roof expanded at Tenampa Restaurant to improve experience and add seating
- Room appliances are being replaced with stainless steel units (phase 1 of 3)
- New bedside lamps, floor lamps, and art pieces have been added to the rooms
- Lobby upholstery has been updated with a vibrant Mexican theme
- New pool chair lift was added
- Spacing between handicap parking spots increased for better loading/unloading
- Benches and shade umbrellas have been added to the designated smoking areas for comfort
- Pool heat exchangers replaced so water temp can remain optimal year round
- Trashcans have been replaced with recycle-friendly receptacles

Cancelation Policy: Our cancellation policy is 24 hours in advance. If you need to change or reduce the number of players in your group, please do so at least 24 hours prior to your tee time. Failure to do so will result in a full charge.

Green Fee includes: 18 holes, one shared golf cart per round, use of driving range prior to round and bottled water.

Please be informed that the State of Baja California Sur has issued a new fee that applies to all international visitors as of November 9, 2019. The ***Fund for a Sustainable Baja California Sur*** will be charged to tourists for each visit to Los Cabos in the amount of \$350 pesos. The Fund will support the betterment of local communities, as well as invest in local resources enjoyed by the millions of travelers who visit the destination every year. The fee can be paid at kiosks located at Los Cabos (SJD) International Airport when leaving, or you can pay any time prior to your departure (including before your trip) online at www.travelerfundbcs.gob.mx. You can also find a FAQ section on this site should you want to learn more about this fund.




Through the maintenance fee section after logging on to www.raintreevacationclub.com with their credentials, Members can opt in to these benefits by following the steps below:

Select the accounts for which you would like to receive E-statements.


