KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

In this installment in our series, we take a look at Club Regina Los Cabos. We have included information on the resort, and some suggestions from the local staff.

CHECK-IN/OUT

Check-in is at 4pm and check-out is at 10am.

CHARGES AT CHECK-IN/OUT

MANDATORY FEES

A mandatory lodging tax of 3% is required by law to be paid by Members by check-out. There is a nightly Club Service fee of US\$3 for a Hotel room, US\$4 for a Club Suite, and US\$5 for a Grand Suite. .

OPTIONAL FEES

Extra person in unit: US\$45 per stay. Late Check-out: guests without prior arrangement who do not check out by 10am will incur a US \$100 charge. Any guests not checked out by 2pm will be charged for an additional night..

BABYSITTING FEES

(Reservation required at least 24 hours in advance)

- *Standard rate: US\$20 per hour (maximum two children)*
- *Rate after 9:00pm: US\$22 per hour*
- *Holiday Rate (Dec. 23 to Jan. 3): US\$25 per hour*
- *More than two children will require a second babysitter*

PARKING

Valet Parking is available for US\$6.00 per day. Complimentary self-parking spaces are very limited and are subject to availability. Self-parking is available at the Westin Resort & Spa, located next door, for US\$11.00 per day.

THEME NIGHTS

Enjoy our theme buffets and drink specials.

On Monday nights at Inizio Restaurant you can enjoy our Mexican Fiesta from 6:00pm to 10:30pm. On Fridays enjoy our grill night from 6:30pm to 10:30pm. Our martinis and tapas special at Bar Vajra runs nightly from 7:00pm to 10:00pm, with two for one specials from 7:00pm to 8:00pm. On Wednesday all you can eat pizza & salad is available at our Pizza & Wine night from 6:00pm to 9:00pm. On Thursday and Sunday nights we have karaoke from 7:00pm to 9pm, and to help with stage fright we have specials on beer buckets. Please note that Theme Nights may change due to weather conditions.

HAPPY HOUR

Even though every hour is happy at Club Regina Los Cabos, there is extra reason to smile with our drink specials throughout the day. Specials run daily at Altura from 1:00pm – 2:00pm, Pool Bar C from 2:00pm – 3:00pm, Bar Vajra from 6:00pm – 7:00pm and Magic Breeze from 9:00pm – 10:00pm.

BEACH AND POOL CHAIRS

For the enjoyment of all Members and guests, please note that beach and pool chairs cannot be reserved. Any items left unattended will be collected for safe keeping by Security.

POOL TOWELS

The towel stand located near the pool is open daily from 9:00am – 7:00pm. At check-in Members are provided with one towel card for each person. Just hand the attendant your card to receive your towels (one towel per card). When you return your towel you will receive your card back.

BBQS

There are no BBQ grills onsite at this resort.

EXERCISE FACILITIES

There are no formal exercise facilities located here, however you can get a great workout walking the paths of the resort, which is built on the side of a bluff overlooking the water. Guests can also use the gym at The Westin Resort & Spa, located next door to Club Regina Los Cabos, at no charge. There are also tennis courts available there for a fee of US\$15.00 per hour (2 people) during the day and US\$25.00 per hour (2 people) from 7:00pm – 11:00pm daily.

KIDS CLUB

Children 5 to 12 years of age can participate in a variety of activities at our Kids Club, open 10:00am – 3:00pm from Monday to Saturday. Your child must be dropped off and picked up by the same parent or guardian and can stay at Kids Club up to three hours per day.

Don Sanchez offers a Chef's tasting menu lunch by reservation only (24 hours notice required) from noon – 4:00pm daily. Dinner service is from 5:00pm – 10:30pm daily. [Acre](#) - Located on 25 acres of farmland adjacent to San Jose del Cabo, Acre is a restaurant, cocktail bar, event space and farm. Everything on the menu and even the walls, furniture, and dishware are local. We recommend the cheddar biscuits, fried tomatoes, and the charred octopus. If you have room, try the chocolate cake for dessert. Acre is open for lunch Monday to Friday from noon – 3:00pm, dinner daily from 5:00pm – 10:00pm, and brunch on Saturdays and Sundays from 10:00am – 3:00pm.

OUR STAFF RECOMMENDS

El Vizcaino Biosphere Reserve - Located at the center of the Baja peninsula between the Pacific Ocean and Sea of Cortez (Gulf of California) lies Mexico's most dramatic and diverse wildlife refuge. Declared a national biosphere in 1988, El Vizcaino has a landmass of over 2.5 million hectares (143,600 square km). This natural reserve has an endless number of attractions such as the wonderful cave paintings guarded by the Sierra San Francisco mountain range. In the contrasting landscapes of this reserve, travelers can observe deserted beaches, lagoons, dunes, mangrove swamps and even islands and islets. This unique paradise-like territory is inhabited by peculiar creatures, some of them endangered species such as the pronghorn, a beautiful antelope, and the Desert Bighorn sheep. Mule deer, loads of migratory birds, wolves, foxes, pumas, marine seals, sea lions, as well as four species of sea turtles live here, too.

Todos Santos (Magic Town) - Todos Santos, with its population of just over 5,000, is located about 90 minutes from Club Regina Los Cabos. It's one of only 30 communities in Mexico to receive the honor of a "Pueblo Magico," or "Magical Town," a designation awarded for retaining its authentic historic and artistic charm. There are at least 20 art galleries on these dusty streets, such as the Galeria Logan, Gabo, and the Faces of Mexico Ethnic Art Gallery, which features some of the area's traditional masks. You can rent a car and tour on your own, or join a guided tour – either way make a day of it.

[Ecotours in Sierra La Laguna](#) - The Sea of Cortez lies to the east and the Pacific Ocean to the west with the granite mountains of the Sierra de la Laguna range rising from the dry tropical forest and sandy shores. The region is a mix of rugged mountains, steep valleys and canyons, and vast dry plains. Baja Sierra Adventures offers a choice of day trips to this area from their base in Santiago, about 40 miles north of San Jose del Cabo. All options include biking, swimming, and hiking. As an eco-tourism company, Baja Sierra Adventures works together with members of the El Chorro community to attract small groups of tourists to this beautiful part of Mexico, without leaving a permanent mark on it. CURRENCY EXCHANGE LIMIT

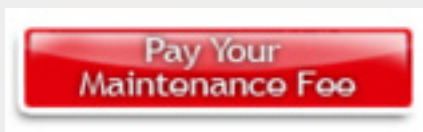
Please be aware that the Mexican government (Sectur) has set limits on the amount of currency that can be exchanged (USD to Mexican pesos) at a hotel. The limits are US\$300 daily for Mexican Nationals, and US\$1,500 daily for all foreigners. There is also a monthly limit for all guests of US\$1,500.

E-STATEMENT ENROLLMENT*

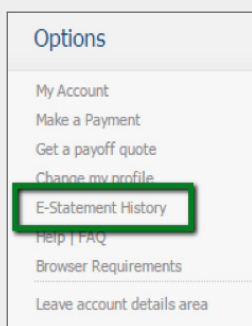

1. Log into raintreevacationclub.com using your personalized credentials and click on **"Pay Your Maintenance Fee"**

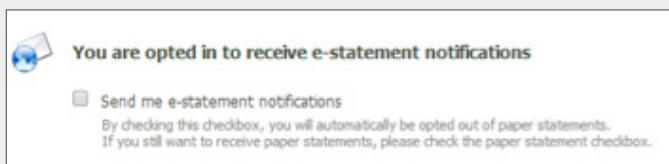


2. In the Options section, select **"E-Statement History"**:

4. Mark the **"Send me e-statement notifications"** checkbox.

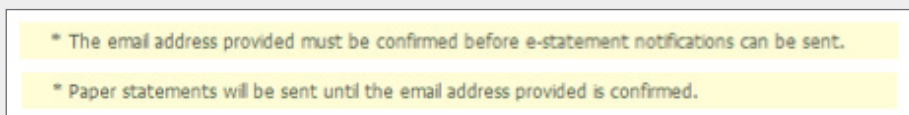


Select the accounts for which you would like to receive E-statements.

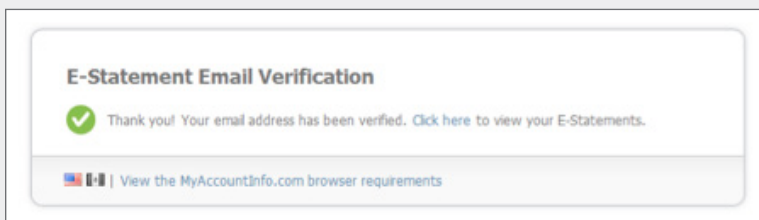
