Whistler Village (Main Village)

Whistler Village is the hub of activity at the base of Whistler Mountain and the only location with direct lift access to both mountains. It is a pedestrian paradise with shops, restaurants and many other amenities close together and a pedestrian only area, so there is no need for a car when staying here. The village is also a thriving local community with a conference center, medical clinic, museum, library, art galleries, spas, over 200 shops and over 90 restaurants for excellent apres and nightlife. So if you are looking to stay in the heart of the action, Whistler Village is the place to be!

Village North

Village North is located right beside the main Whistler Village, and via the pedestrian overpass, it is within easy walking distance of the village and the gondolas. Village North is centered around the Whistler Marketplace which offers a supermarket, video store and other amenities, making it a very convenient location. If you like the idea of being more secluded, choose Valhalla which is the furthest away from the main village; if you prefer to be closer, Tyndall Stone Lodge is right on the pedestrian stroll.

Upper Village

The Upper Village is situated at the base of Blackcomb Mountain, serviced by the Wizard and Magic Chair lifts, and is home to our ski-in/out properties. The nearby Lost Lake, Chateau Whistler Golf Club, and a weekly farmer's market are popular in the summertime and there's lots of year-round activities as well. This neighborhood connects to Whistler Village by a pedestrian walkway for convenient access to all its amenities and lifts. The Upper Village is surrounded by towering pines, creating an idyllic sense of alpine seclusion where visitors can be on the slopes or the greens in no time.

Creekside

For those looking for a mellower Whistler experience, Creekside is an excellent alternative to the main village with its own gondola, restaurants and shops. It's only about a 5 minute drive to Whistler Village, or skiers can get here from Whistler Mountain via the Creekside Gondola. Steeped in history, this charming revitalized area was the site of Whistler's first ski runs in the 1960s and was the host venue of the 2010 Winter Olympics. Today, the 'Creek', as locals call it, is a laid-back, family kind of place with access to parks and lakes that offer numerous activities year-round.

Blueberry Hill

Blueberry Hill is a prestigious residential neighborhood with breathtaking, panoramic views of Blackcomb Mountain. Surrounded by the Whistler Golf Course and the beaches of Alta Lake, this area is prime for the leisure enthusiast. Blueberry Hill is a 30 minute walk to Creekside's Town Centre and Gondola and a 15 minute walk to Whistler Village, which gives visitors convenient access to shops, restaurants, and of course the slopes.

NEW SCAMMER NOTICE

We recently became aware of an individual purporting to be a Raintree employee who has contacted a Raintree Vacation Club ("RVC") member via the email address vacationowner@clubmember.org with an offer to cancel their membership for \$950. In an attempt to make the "offer" look more official, this person also misappropriated both the names and logos of RVC and Club Regina, Los Cabos. Please be aware that this person does not work for Raintree, and that this cancellation offer is fake. Additionally, our member services email addresses all use the domain name raintreeclub.com and never clubmember.org. Any time someone contacts you with a membership opportunity, a cancellation offer, or an offer to lease/rent or sell your timeshare using this email address, or any sort of variation of our listed domain name above, it should serve as a warning sign of a scam.

If you are contacted by the individual listed above, or any who act in a similar fashion, please let us know by calling our vacation guides at 1.800.424.6532 / 317.805.9167. Additionally, please refer to this email's attachment for lists of other known scammers and common warning signs.

- **Timeshare Exit Team (Reedhein & Associates)**

When contacted by anyone offering to sell, rent or otherwise dispose of your timeshare, please be aware of the following warning signs:

- **Unrealistic rental or sale prices for your timeshare**
- **Payment of upfront fees, such as taxes, transfer fees or prepaid maintenance fees, usually via wire transfer or cashier's check, which will be reimbursed at closing.**
- **Use of name and trademarks of Raintree Vacation Club ("RVC") on entity's website, emails or written materials (RVC does not endorse or is affiliated with any reseller or rental company)**
- **Request for your RVC username and password or for a limited power of attorney concerning your timeshare**
- **Claim that the entity/individual is affiliated/employed with Raintree Vacation Club**

We strongly urge our Members to use extreme caution when contacted by individuals or companies who make claims that just seem too good to be true. Before doing anything, carefully research the individual or entity involved. Despite having professional-looking salesmen and websites, many of these companies are not legitimate.



E-STATEMENT ENROLLMENT*


Continuing in Raintree Vacation Club's efforts to "Go Green", Members now have the option to opt in for Electronic Maintenance Fee statements instead of the paper statements that are mailed to the address on file.

Through the maintenance fee section after logging on to www.raintreevacationclub.com with their credentials, Members can opt in to these benefits by following the steps below:

1. Log into [raintreevacationclub.com](http://www.raintreevacationclub.com) using your personalized credentials and click on **"Pay Your Maintenance Fee"**




2. In the Options section, select **"E-Statement History"**:



3. This will open your E-Statement

4. Mark the **"Send me e-statement notifications"** checkbox.



Select the accounts for which you would like to receive E-statements.


Select an email address by using the **"Select an Email Address"** drop-down list. If the email address that you wish notification to go to is not listed, enter the email address in the **"Enter in an email address"** box.

Click the **'Save Changes'** button

5. Members will be sent an email requesting them to confirm the e-mail address. The following messages will display:

* The email address provided must be confirmed before e-statement notifications can be sent.
 * Paper statements will be sent until the email address provided is confirmed.

6. From the email, click the link. The email confirmation page opens:
