In the US it is a tradition to watch the countdown and “ball drop” from Times Square in New York City. Parties can range from small to elaborate, but you will likely find noise makers, champagne, toasts, fireworks or sparklers, and the tradition of kissing your loved one at midnight no matter what gathering you attend. There are also many food traditions for New Year’s day. Black-eyed peas are perhaps the most common and well-known of good luck foods. Green symbolizes money and prosperity, which is why collard greens are also often found at the New Year’s table. Southern tradition also teaches that they can be hung by the door to scare away evil spirits. So, eat them or hang them by your door — your choice!

In Mexico on December 31st at midnight it is a tradition to eat 12 grapes – one with each of the twelve chimes of the bell during the New Year’s countdown, while making a wish with each one. On New Year’s Eve, men and women who want to find love wear red underwear. They wear yellow if they want



prosperity, and white to bring peace. Get ready for this one: If you want to travel (which we hope you do) take your luggage outside and walk around the block with it. This is supposed to bring you lots of trips in the future!

In Canada the celebrations vary according to the region, so you can find fun and unique things to do almost everywhere. Besides celebrations with music, parties, and fireworks, the most famous tradition is to go ice fishing with friends and family as fish are said to bring abundance to your New Year. A fast-growing tradition all around the world is the Polar Bear Plunge which first originated in Vancouver, BC in 1920. People run into freezing cold lakes and oceans as a rejuvenating and cleansing start to their new year.

David Galvis

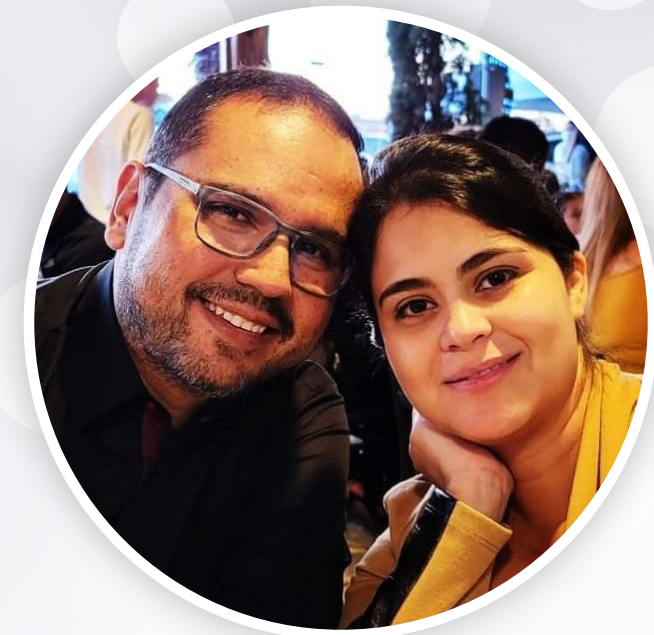

We can’t wait to be at our “second home” in March!



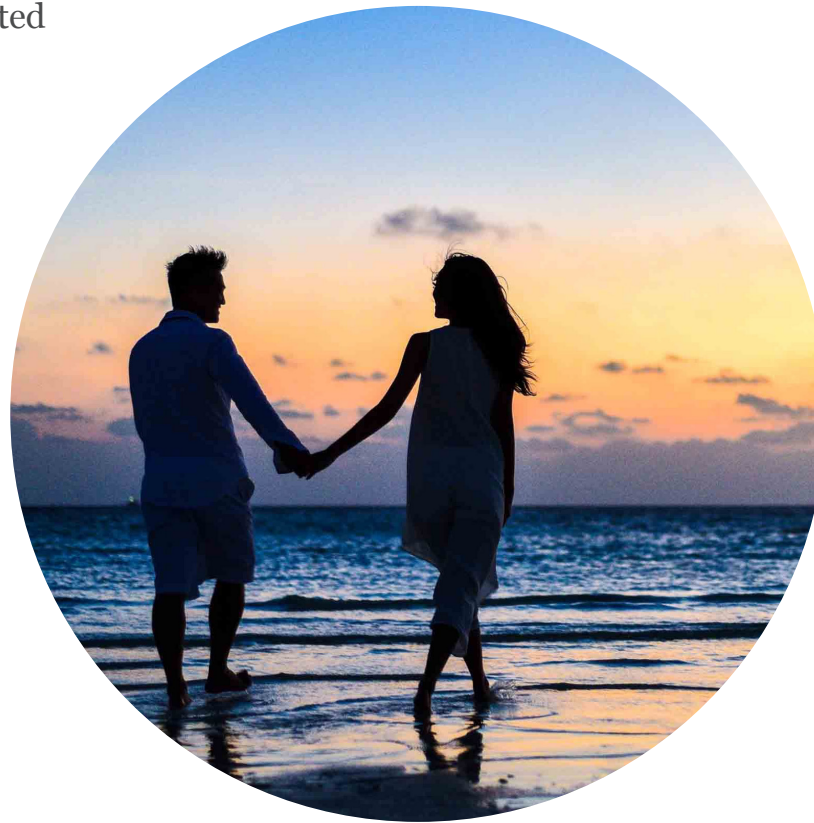
Travel News

All our resorts are open and without restrictions!

We thank you for your participation and understanding these last three years while we took every measure to keep our members, guests, and employees safe. We will continue to remain vigilant for you by maintaining our high-standard sanitation and hygiene practices at every property.

In the last few months both the Canadian and Mexican governments have followed suit with the US and lifted their mask requirements on airlines and at the airports. This now means that nearly all mask mandates for the public across Canada, the United States, and Mexico have been eliminated, and guests are no longer required to wear a mask at any Raintree property. Exceptions do apply in certain high-risk settings such as hospitals, other health services facilities, and for some regions of Mexico, while on public transportation.

Because of this, we will discontinue the Covid-19 Update page on our website in the new year.

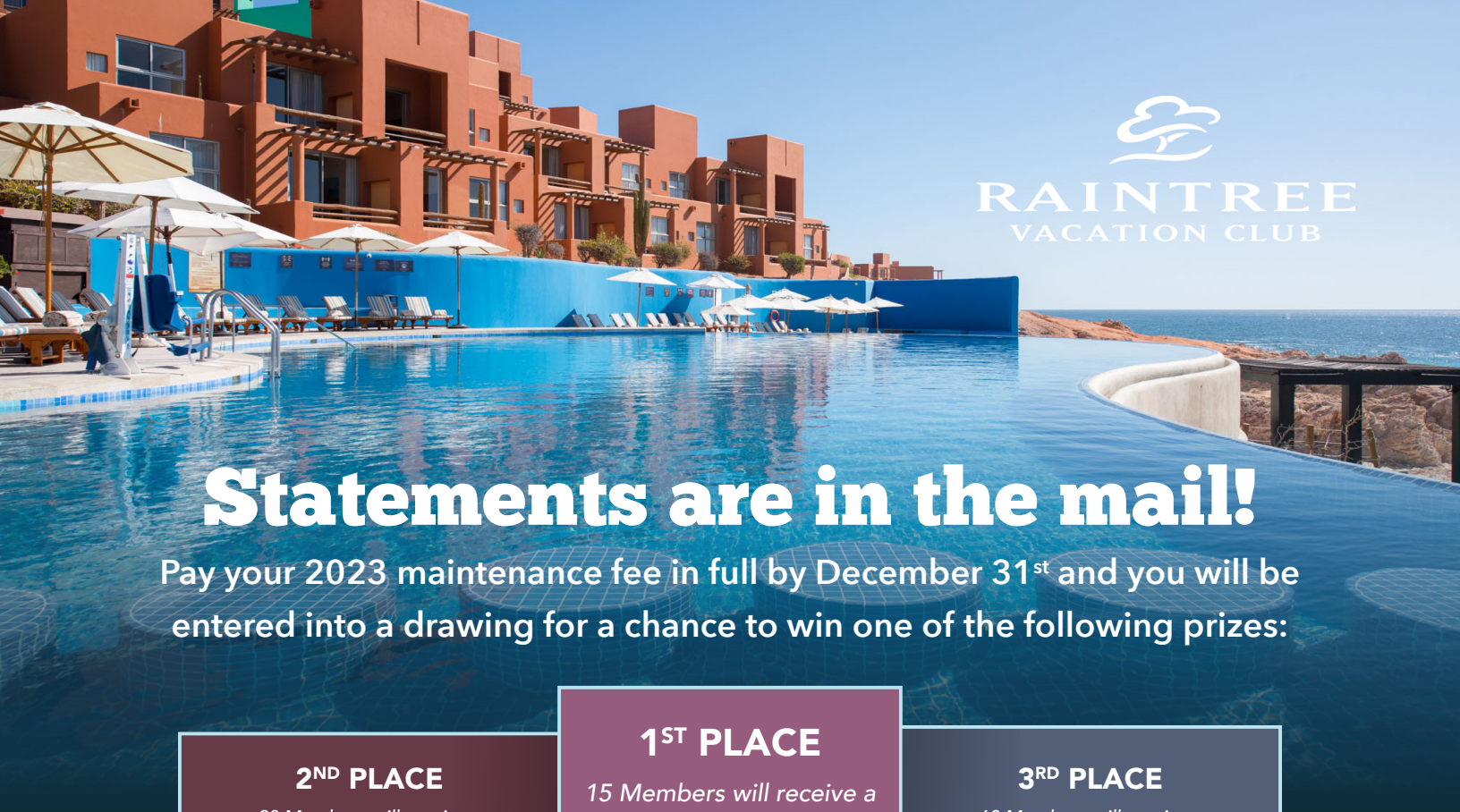

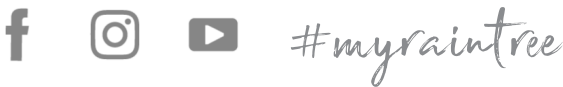
